NBA Kicks Off it's Regional Summer Conferences in SD

Approximately 90 bison enthusiasts are descending on the Black Hills of South Dakota today for the NBA's first regional summer conference.

The event kicks off Friday evening with a welcome reception at the host hotel, the Rapid City Ramkota. Attendees will enjoy networking and beverages before a summer dinner of bison brats and bison chili, generously donated by Dakota Pure. Attendees will then have some fun activities to raise funds for the NBA, and will conclude with the auctioning of a one of a kind 2007 International Bison Conference commemorative Harley Davidson motorcycle to support bison industry pioneer, Bruce Anderson - see story below.

On Saturday, attendees will travel to the 777 Bison Ranch in Hermosa, SD for a full day of bison education, networking and feasting. Speakers include Glenn Plumb, current chair of the IUCN Bison Working Group will update the group on strides in global bison restoration. 777's Cody Smith will discuss his approach to bison herd management on the ranch during the herd and pasture tour. NBA's board director, Liz Riffle, will lead a Holistic Management 101 course, and we'll also hear from local USDA NRCS agents on regenerative grazing practices suited to bison producers, and much more.



Bruce and Martha Anderson are presenting an opportunity to own a Limited Edition 2007 International Bison Conference (IBC) Harley Davidson Heritage Softail. This beautiful motorcycle, with a custom paint job tailored to the owner, was purchased and proudly ridden by Bruce for many years.

One of a group of 15 limited edition motorcycles, these bikes were the primary fundraiser for the 2007 International Bison Conference. Bruce was instrumental in planning and executing that conference and further showed his support by purchasing #13 of the motorcycles.

This beautiful motorcycle features a custom paint job with the 2007 IBC logo, number 13, and a bison scene on the gas tank. The bike has 12,181 miles (it may have a few more very limited miles by auction time), bison leather saddlebags, and a seat crafted by Lonnie's Boot & Saddle in Rapid City, SD. Flat Earth Art & Sign in Spearfish, SD, did the artwork, and the paint was done by the Body and Collision Center in Belle Fourche, SD. Black Hills Harley Davidson partnered with the IBC Committee to make these motorcycles available for purchase, auction and raffle.

The motorcycle will be offered at a simulcast auction on Friday, June 16, during the NBA Northern Regional Conference in Rapid City, SD, at the Ramkota Hotel. Bidders will be able to bid live or online. The motorcycle will be on display during the Friday evening reception prior to the auction.
