**Tour Highlights:** *Firehole Falls, Firehole Canyon, the Fountain Paint Pots (short hike), Firehole Lake Drive, Old Faithful Geyser, Old Faithful Inn, Yellowstone Lake, the Lake Hotel, the Hayden Valley, the Grand Canyon of the Yellowstone (South Rim), Upper Falls, Lower Falls, Crystal Falls and Gibbon Falls.*

**Common Wildlife:** *Elk, bison are common; coyotes, grizzly bears and moose are sometimes spotted in the spring and fall. The Bison Rut is in mid August. Geysers and thermal activity is at its best in the warmer summer months.*

**Tour Highlights:** *Gibbon Falls, Tower Falls, the Petrified Tree, Undine Falls, Gardiner Stage Coach Road (if open), Mammoth Hot Springs, Fort Yellowstone, The Blacktail Plateau Stagecoach Road (if open), the Chittenden Road, the Hoo Doos, Rustic Falls, the Golden gate Canyon and Bridge and Obsidian Cliff.*

**Common Wildlife:** *Elk, Black Bears, Bison and Pronghorn are common; there numbers are best in spring and falls. Grizzly Bears, Coyotes and Big Horn Sheep are occasionally sighted. Of course, a Moose is possible in the Gallatin District and Big Sky Area*
