ELIGIBILITY: The NBA Winter Conference Art Contest is open to children and grandchildren of NBA members and InterTribal Buffalo Council members. There will be two divisions — Grades 7 through 9 and Grades 10-12. Prizes will be awarded to first, second and third places in each category.

RULES:

- Only one entry per artist. Each entry must be the sole work of the artist.
- Entries should be original works of art (no tracings or computer-generated material).
- Artwork must be two-dimensional and must be submitted on flat paper. Do not roll or fold. Entries should be no larger than 18 x 24 inches.
- Any medium can be used (pen and ink, crayon, paint, pencil, pastel, watercolor, etc.).
- Entries should have the following information securely affixed to the back: name of artist, age, grade.
- Entries must be received by January 2.
- A complete entry form and contest release form must be submitted with each artist's entry.
- Entries will not be returned and will become the property of the NBA.
- By entering, the artist gives the NBA permission to use the artwork for the association's purposes.
- Winners will be announced January 15, 2018 and will be notified by telephone or mail.
- Entries will be judged based on creativity, originality, use of color, use of space and clarity.
- All submissions will be displayed at the NBA Winter Conference in Denver, CO.
- Winning entries will be auctioned at the NBA Winter Conference Benefit Auction, with proceeds benefitting the artist.
