***Correction to Grain Fed Bison Cuts. ***

For the month of October, prices of bison cuts trended slightly lower when compared to September. Pounds of bison were steady to slightly lower. Canadian bison imports were 4 percent higher and actual slaughter numbers were 14 percent lower than September totals.
