	The majority of the heifer calves were in the \$4.30 to \$4.60 range.						
	Yearling heifers were fairly steady at \$4.00						
	Yearling bulls were fairly steady at \$4.00 for the mid range weight bulls. A few heavy bulls and the bottom end brought the average price down a bit.						
	As always the meat market was the driving force in price discovery but an obvious intrest in breeding stock was present throughout the sale.						
	There was a wide variety of buyers present and no one dominated the bidding on any class.						
	All in all it was a fantastic sale and we'd really like to thank all the consignors and buyers.
