Ranch Ready Lot Number: 999 A-E

Consignor Comments: Weaned on January 2, 2017. Fed weaning ration and free-choice hay. April 15, 2017 – put on pasture.

November 15, 2017 – Penned and fed free-choice grass hay. December 23, 2017 – free-choice grass hay and 5 lbs. cake.

Ranch Ready Lot Number: 483 A-E

Consignor Comments: Calves were run through the chute and tagged in December, then kicked back out on native prairie grass with their mothers. They also had access to 14% DD6 cake with the herd at approximately 2lbs./head, every other day, December – February. The following December, they were brought into the corrals where they received free choice native grass hay and access to a creep feed ration consisting of corn (80%), oats (10%), trace mineral pellet (10%). They were sorted out of a group of 50 heifers that were randomly gate cut.
