Thank you for your letter of March 27, 2020, urging the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) to ensure that America's bison producers are included in any assistance program implemented for the livestock sector and that any compensation for producers are based upon market prices before March 2020 due to the economic impacts of the coronavirus (COVID-19) outbreak. Your comments and recommendations are appreciated.

Rest assured that we at USDA are continuously working to support our customers and partners. We recognize these are uncertain times for all Americans and share your concerns about the effects of COVID-19 on the bison industry. The USDA is taking the COVID-19 pandemic very seriously. We are actively monitoring the situation as it evolves and will take appropriate steps to respond and protect the food supply chain to the extent Congress has authorized.

I appreciate you highlighting the struggles that the bison industry is experiencing as it faces the COVID-19 outbreak.
